The Membership, Nominating and Bylaws Committee

Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) Committee:

The Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) Committee (the "CQI Committee") is chaired by the Second Vice President, and consists of a co-chair appointed by the Second Vice President, representatives of each category of Trustee, and other individuals as appointed by the President or CQI Committee chair/co-chair from among the Trustees and/or other community representatives/agencies as interested and invited. The CQI Committee is responsible for performing all quality assurance, clinical review, education and planning functions of the Consortium. The CQI Committee reports to and make recommendations to the Board regarding its activities. The CQI Committee subcommittees is made up of representatives of each category of Trustee, and community representatives/agencies as interested and invited. The CQI Committee meets as often as deemed necessary but at least annually. Minutes shall be kept of all meetings.

Interdisciplinary Case Review Team (ICRT):

All cases of maternal mortality, maternal transport with death, selected pediatric deaths, pediatric transport with death, women delivering after receiving no prenatal care, non-compliance with rules regarding birth weight and gestational age, neonatal transports with death and fetal deaths >2500 gms are reported to the Consortium by birth hospitals. A CJFHC nurse conducts a medical chart audit of selected cases and de-identified summaries of these cases are provided to the team. The Interdisciplinary Case Review Team is a group of healthcare professionals that meets 6 times a year to review such cases as listed above, Fetal Infant Mortality Review cases, and makes recommendations on how the region can improve care. The ICRT is a subcommittee of the CQI Committee and is made up of Trustees and/or other individuals/agencies including community agencies.
